### Aims of the policy

- All pupils have a safe coordinated lunchtime
- All pupils have a clear understanding of expectations during lunchtime
- Promote an ethos of a happy, healthy, safe lunchtime for all

### Purpose of the policy

At Walton Priory our ethos (beliefs, attitudes and values) should consistently be positive in order to give all the pupils the opportunity to conduct themselves in a safe, friendly environment.

- All staff are responsible for maintaining good standards of behaviour.
- All staff provide common reference for rewarding and sanctioning behaviour.
- All staff adhere to the lunchtime, behaviour and code of conduct policies.

### Appropriate Behaviour

- All pupils will eat in the designated dining hall or in the designated yard appropriate to their year group.
- All litter and uneaten food will be disposed of correctly in the bins provided.
- All those on packed lunches should collect their lunch from the cloakroom at the start of lunch and only return to the cloakroom at the end of lunch.
- Pupils should not be within the cloakroom for any other reason than collecting a packed lunch.
- Year 5 will remain on the top yard at all times unless a member of staff dictates otherwise.
- Football is to be played in the designated areas for Year 6, 7 and 8 and should be played in a safe manner with due regard to all members of the Walton Priory Middle School community.
- Those wishing to talk and play should not do so on the football playing areas. They are to find a suitable safe location away from the football area.
- Due regard should be given to the state of your school uniform and the appropriate condition of it.
- Pupils should be polite, respectful and well-mannered when speaking to any member of the Walton Priory Middle School community.
- Pupils must follow all directions given to them by and member of school staff.
- Pupils should not enter the library unless they are there for a specific lunchtime club.

### Wet weather lunchtime

If the weather at lunchtime is inclement and is classed as a "wet" lunchtime the additional rules must be followed:

- Year 5 and 6 will be based in their own form classroom when not eating in the dining hall.
- Year 7 will be based in their own form classroom when not eating in the dining hall.
- Year 8 will be based in the main hall area when not eating in the dining hall.
- No food will be taken into the classrooms, the main hall or any other area under any circumstances.
- Pupils should remember that within school all of the codes of conduct and behaviour policies still apply during a "wet" lunchtime.
