France

Monday 5th to Friday 9th June 2023

Arrive at school for: 1.00am, leave luggage outside, come into school via the old reception and register.

Hand over any medication, ensure inhalers are kept on you.

Hand passports in as you get on to the coach.

You will stop at the motorway services after a couple of hours

Leave school for Calais: 1.20am

Arrive in Dover approx: 9.00am

Depart dover: 10.30am (ferry crossing 90mins)

Arrive at Calais: 1.00pm (1hr time difference)

Depart Calais: Head to PGL Chateau De Grande Romaine to arrive around: 5.30pm

- ▶ Students will be in activity groups of 13 or 14 and assigned a group leader.
 - ▶ Groups 1, 2, 3 will be on coach 1
 - ▶ Groups 4,5,6 will be on coach 2
 - ▶ The groupings will be announced on Wednesday at the end of competitive sports.
 - ▶ Students will not be allowed to switch groups or change coaches at any time.

PGL Chateau De Grande Romaine



- Rooms are all ensuite and sleep between 4-7 students.
- Keys are allocated 2 per room, therefore 2 people will be solely responsible.
- Your team leader will collect your key cards in every morning after breakfast and return them to you at the end of the afternoon activities.

Where are going and what are we doing?

- ▶ **Monday** – arrive in Calais around 1.00pm Stop en-route to the chateau at the Vimy Ridge War Memorial. Arrive at your accommodation approx 5.30pm where you will check in, have your evening meal.
- ▶ **Tuesday** – Visit to local market and preparaez a manger (€3-5), then we head off to the hypermarket to shop! The afternoon will be back at the chateau where you will take part in Fabrication de tarte a la Francaise.
- ▶ **Wednesday** – We'll head to Provins – Legend of the Knights, followed by an afternoon in the swimming pool on site at the Chateau.
- ▶ **Thursday** – Visit the Chateau du Foutainebleau and the afternoon will be a visit to the town of Fountainbleau.
- ▶ **Friday** – We will be packed and ready to leave back to the UK. However, we will stop en-route at the Chocolataire de Lachelle which is a chocolatiers. We will arrive in Calais around 2.30pm for the ferry home. Arrival back at school will be approx. 10.30pm

Evening Entertainment:

- ▶ There will be evening entertainment on site, which will be provided by the PGL entertainment team 😊

Free Times on site:

- ▶ There will be free time where there are communal areas, sports to play such as basketball, football, volleyball etc. There are floodlights and PGL provide the equipment.

Timings of day:

- ▶ Breakfast: 7.30 – 8.30am
- ▶ Lunch: Between 12.00 – 1.00pm
- ▶ Evening meal: 6.00 – 7.30pm
- ▶ Evening Entertainment: 8.00 – 8.30pm
- ▶ Bed time: in your rooms by 10.00pm
- ▶ Quiet by 10.30pm (This is a Chateau Rule)
- ▶ Shop on site is open 5.30 – 8.30pm

Travel

Coach

- ▶ Three activity groups allocated per coach
- ▶ Each coach has a first aider
- ▶ Safety – seatbelts worn at all times
- ▶ Rubbish, unwanted food, drinks etc must be put in bins provided

Ferry

- ▶ There will be a central place for whole group (identified when we get on the ferry)
- ▶ Must be in groups of 3 or more
- ▶ Shop – go to the shop in small groups (large groups won't be allowed) member of staff needs to be in the shop area
- ▶ For safety reasons, only allowed outside on the deck with a member of staff – behaviour process will be followed
- ▶ Ferry has it's own rules about children not entering the bar area and no passengers on the car deck whilst the ferry is in motion.

Food...

- ▶ Breakfast:

Cereal, fruit, yoghurts, pastries etc, hot drinks

- ▶ Lunch:

You make your own baguette each day, choice of fillings and snacks

- ▶ Evening meal:

Soup and hot buffet style menu with some occasional French delights!!!

Please note the venue is a NUT FREE Site!!

Money...

- ▶ You will need both English money and Euros.
- ▶ We recommend £40.00 English which you will be able to spend at the motorway services and on the ferry.
- ▶ We recommend €50.00 for the trip to the hypermarket, to spend in the shop on site that sells sweets, snacks and drinks etc and for the visit to the local market.
- ▶ Your money is solely your responsibility
- ▶ You need to manage and budget your money especially your English money as you will need to save money for your return travel

What to bring/not to bring:

- ▶ The **MOST IMPORTANT THING IS YOUR PASSPORT!!!!**
- ▶ UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIUC) if you have one
- ▶ Money
- ▶ Packed lunch plus extra snacks/drinks

DO NOT BRING

- ▶ Spray deodorants/spray perfumes or aftershaves
- ▶ Chewing Gum – this is banned for all travel
- ▶ Vapes/cigarettes
- ▶ Alcohol
- ▶ Hair Straighteners



BEHAVIOUR

- ▶ Poor behaviour will not be tolerated.
- ▶ Although out of school, you are still representing the school and we expect the same high standards of behaviour
- ▶ Normal school rules apply regarding behaviour
- ▶ You will remain in the activity groups you are put in for all activities off site
- ▶ If there are any major behaviour or safeguarding concerns your parents will be contacted and behaviour procedures will be followed

Mobile phones

- ▶ Mobile phones will be allowed but due to safeguarding they are not permitted in any of the bedrooms
- ▶ Data roaming is your responsibility, any costs incurred are not the responsibility of the school.
- ▶ You will need to charge your phones during breakfast time, free time or evening time in the communal areas
- ▶ Mobiles will be handed out at breakfast time and returned to your group leader before you go to bed
- ▶ We recommend you bring a battery charging pack to support the charging of your phone
- ▶ Photo's are only for your own memories and not to be sent or forwarded – **REMEMBER YOU MUST GET CONSENT BEFORE YOU TAKE A PHOTO OF SOMEONE!**
- ▶ Any miss use of your mobile and it will be confiscated until the end of your trip where it will be handed directly to your parents/carers.
