Re: Year 6 SATs Booster Breakfast Club

As we approach an important phase in your child's academic journey, we are excited to inform you about an upcoming opportunity that will contribute significantly to their preparation for the Year 6 SATs tests.

After careful consideration, we have organised a Year 6 SATs Booster Breakfast Club, which will commence on 25th February. This club aims to provide short, targeted revision sessions to enhance your child's understanding and confidence in preparation for the upcoming SATs tests. Children can choose from a Spelling Punctuation and Grammar focus (SPaG), reading or a targeted maths focus (Arithmetic).

An optional breakfast can also be purchased for £1.29 from the canteen each morning, which will include a piece of toast and a drink of hot chocolate. Breakfast will be provided free of charge for those in receipt of pupil premium.

Date	Topic
25 th Feb	4 operations – addition & subtraction, start multiplication & division methods
4 th March	4 operations – mostly long division, long multiplication
11 th March	4 operations with decimals
18 th March	4 operations with decimals – mostly multiplying/dividing by 10, 100, 1000
25 th March	Fractions – adding and subtracting
15 th April	Fractions – Mixed Numbers and Improper Fractions
22 nd April	Fractions – multiplying and dividing
29 th April	Fractions/percentages of amounts
6 th May:	Fraction/decimals/percentages - equivalency

We understand that mornings can be busy, but we believe that starting the day with a focused and constructive activity will set a positive tone for your child's overall learning experience. The club will be led by our experienced and dedicated staff, who are committed to providing tailored support to meet the individual needs of each student.

Participation in the Year 6 Booster Breakfast Club is entirely voluntary, and we encourage you to discuss this opportunity with your child. We believe that this additional support will complement their regular classroom learning and contribute to their success in the upcoming SATs tests.
